- ✗ Common seating areas.
- ✗ Newspapers, magazines and musical instruments.
- ✗ Study rooms and meeting room rentals.



How we're keeping you safe

- Occupancy limits, per Provincial guidelines.
- Providing hand sanitizer and face masks, as needed.
- Reorganized spaces for physical distancing, including barriers at service points.
- Isolating all returned materials for 72+ hours.
- Increased sanitation schedule.
- Staff training on safety measures.
